

## UCEAP-UCR Scholarship

As part of the UCEAP scholarship initiative, UCR has been granted an allocation of funds for scholarships. This scholarship will be for students of all backgrounds and majors and for all available UCEAP study abroad programs. This scholarship will be awarded in two application cycles: 1) Northern Hemisphere programs that depart in summer, fall, and year, and 2) Southern Hemisphere programs that depart in spring and year (off-cycle).

### Eligibility

The award selections will be primarily based on academic merit and integration of a selected UCEAP program into a student's academic and career goals, as demonstrated in a personal statement. Students with financial need or who are traditionally under-represented in UCEAP programs should include the impact these elements have had on their decision to study abroad. Under-represented students include those who have transferred to UCR from a California community college or state university, veterans, first-generation college students, and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) majors.

### Scholarship Deadlines:

- Summer, Fall, and Year applications are due February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Winter, Spring, and Year (off-cycle) applications are due October 1<sup>st</sup>.

## UCR Study Abroad Programs Scholarship

The UCR Study Abroad Programs Scholarship is to support students participating on the UC Education Abroad Program (UCEAP) and Opportunities Abroad Programs (OAP). This scholarship will be for students of all backgrounds and majors and for all available UCEAP and OAP study abroad programs. This scholarship will be awarded in two application cycles: 1) Northern Hemisphere programs that depart in summer, fall, and year, and 2) Southern Hemisphere programs that depart in spring and year (off-cycle).

### Eligibility

The award selections will be primarily based on academic merit and integration of a selected study abroad program into a student's academic and career goals, as demonstrated in a personal statement. Student must be currently enrolled at UCR and have had no prior study abroad experience. Scholarships will be awarded for the following categories:

- Students with financial need.
- Students who demonstrate academic achievement.
- Students participating in traditionally under-represented countries and/or programs.
- Students who are sophomore or junior standing during their study abroad program.
- Under-represented students include those who have transferred to UCR from a California community college or state university, veterans, first-generation college students, and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) majors.

### Scholarship Deadlines:

- Summer, Fall, and Year applications are due February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Winter, Spring, and Year (off-cycle) applications are due October 1<sup>st</sup>.
