

EDUCATION ABROAD SUMMER PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The International Affairs Education Abroad Summer Program Scholarship Fund is a merit-based scholarship opportunity for undergraduate and graduate students from the University of California, Riverside campus enrolled in a faculty-led, summer program.

Individual scholarships up to \$1,000 will be awarded to students enrolled in one of the 2017 Summer Education Abroad Programs.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student must be a UC Riverside undergraduate or graduate student;
- Student must be enrolled in UC Riverside Education Abroad Summer 2017 Program and must have submitted all required forms and additional information requested in the Student Information Packet;
- Student must submit two copies of a one-page, typed **statement of purpose** describing:
 - interest in the Summer Study Abroad Program you have selected;
 - how the study abroad experience applies to your academic and professional goals;
 - a proposed project to share your study abroad experience with the community upon your return in one paragraph. Examples of past student service projects include: volunteer tabling at Education Abroad events, in-class presentations, and program specific blogs;
 - Upon completion of your service project, you are required to follow up with your Study Abroad advisor.
- Please add your name and UCR student identification number.

Application Deadline: Friday, May 26, 2017 by 4:00PM (no exceptions)

The scholarship announcement will be made on the Summer Study Abroad website. Individual recipients will be notified by email and/or telephone prior to posting.
